International Baccalaureate Diploma Program

The **International Baccalaureate Diploma Program** is an optional program that has a duration of two years, specifically in the tenth and eleventh grade years of High School. The program's main objective is to train people with excellent breadth and depth of knowledge, along with physical, intellectual, emotional, and ethical growth. Applicants to the IB Diploma will receive their National Baccalaureate degree accredited by the Ministry of Public Education simultaneously, according to current regulations.

Our students do not have to do an additional year after eleventh grade to obtain the International Baccalaureate Diploma.

Entry requirements

- 1. Parent interview with the School Support Department.

- 8. Complete Registration Form and Service Contract.
- 9. Complete image consent permissions.
- 10. File of other institutions, in the cases that apply.
- 11. Certification of Financial Status of the institution of origin, in the cases that apply.
